Help her find the way to the entrance.

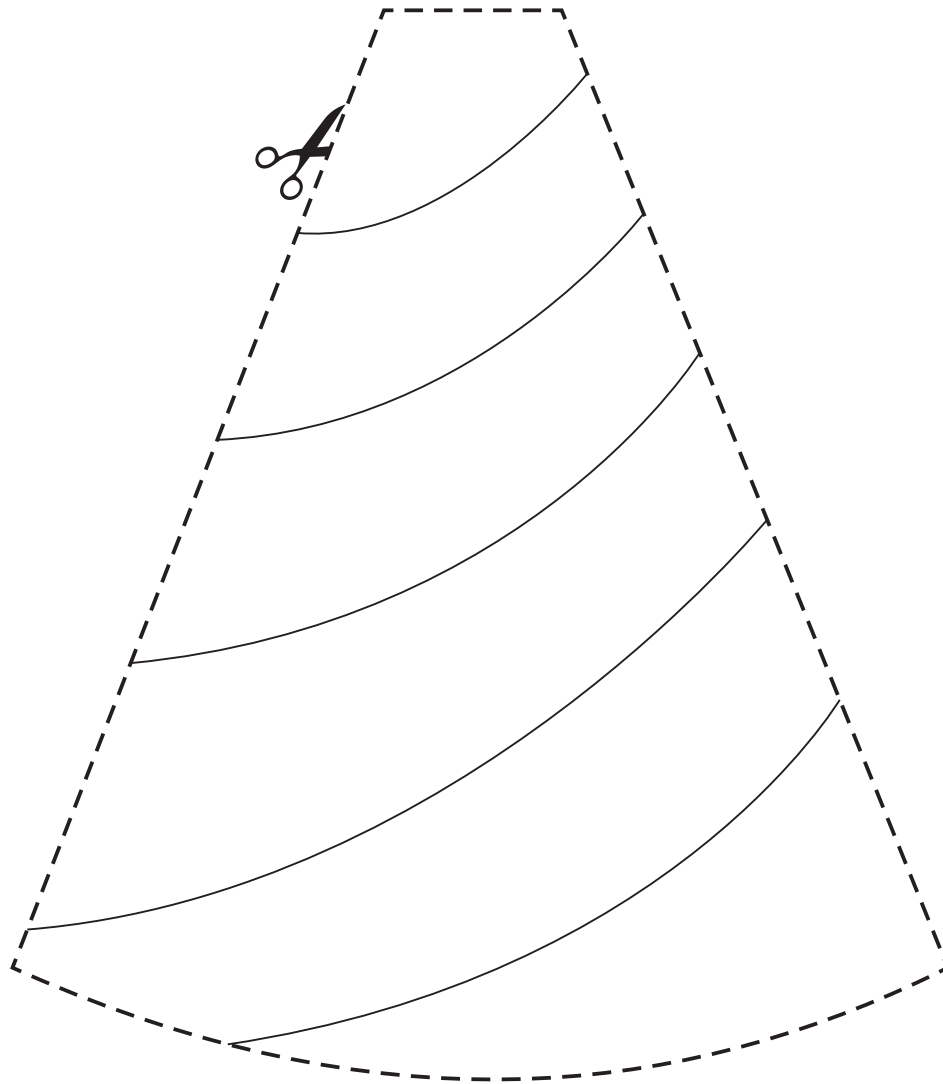

MAKE YOUR OWN UNICORN HORN

Decorate the horn below. Then, with an adult's help, cut along the dotted line. Roll the paper into a cone shape and add tape to hold the horn together. Poke two holes on opposite sides of the cone and thread a ribbon or string through both holes, tying a knot at each hole.
