

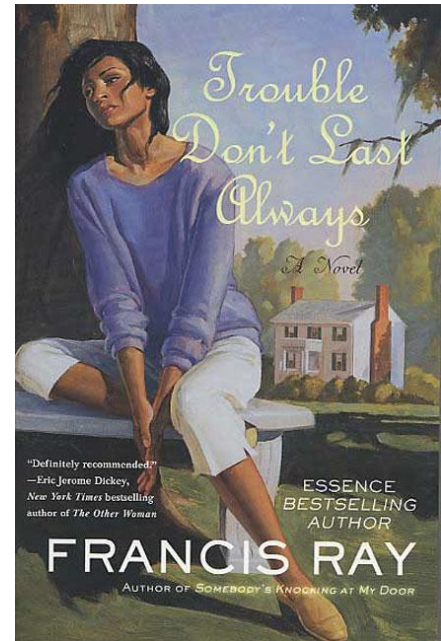

## Discussion Questions

1. Did Lilly pay too high a price by staying with Myron? Do you agree with her reasons for staying? Why or why not?
2. What is the one thing that you feel you could never forgive your significant other for?
3. Should Adam share the blame with the carjackers for his blindness?
4. How did Lilly's and Adam's families influence their lives?
5. What part did faith play in the lives of Lilly and Adam?
6. What lesson about life and love did all the characters have to learn?
7. Has there been a turning point in your life, and if so, who or what influenced it and how has it changed your life?
