5. Give your thoughts on Lola. Is Lola anxious to become a star because she wants fame or is she ambitious for other reasons? What would these reasons be?
6. Being in a relationship is difficult for Fletcher because he wants to please Megan and Lola. At one point, Fletcher and Megan get into an argument about Lola. Did you find yourself taking sides? If so, with whom?
7. How do you perceive Megan? Do you think she had real feelings for Fletcher? Do you fault her for getting frustrated and leaving?
8. At first, Emma doesn't believe in synchronicity, but she changes her mind. Have you had strong beliefs about something that changed over the course of time? If so, what happened to change them?
9. Vermont is a perfect Christmas destination. There are so many quaint towns and fun things to do. What is your favorite Christmas destination and why?
